2023 Course # 412.1 The Church in Areas of Social Tension/ Social Justice

Course Description: How do we address racism, hate, and gross systemic injustice as authentic Christians. We are seeking to clearly define authentic Christianity based on the Holy Scriptures. This course will help students understand the role of the Christian Church during social crisis. This course is a kind of pre-clinical perspective of how the church should behave amid social tensions as a redeemed community.

The student will be introduced to financial literacy and planning, and also wealth building for the family, and financial management. The students will learn hiring and firing practices and how they affect the wealth gap. This class is designed to bring awareness to economic and financial challenges and help end the cycle of poverty in the black community.

It will endeavor to make the point that disciples are made and not born. Efforts will be put forth to equip students for life in the real world. Spiritual reality must be made distinct from the whims of human leaders. This is a practical, Biblical approach to revolutionizing the work of the ministry Christ called us to in the Great Commission.
